

# 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Brooklawn's Intense Games Event #1 – Human Crane

---

**PARTICIPANTS:** All team members

**TIME ALLOWED:** This is a timed event – **5:00** or until all 15 tumblers have been stacked

**SCORING:** Based on the number and placement of tumblers (see below)

---

## EVENT RULES:

- *Each team will have 15 plastic tumblers with an eyehook on the bottom and a 4-foot PVC pipe "human crane" with a rope/hook attached to a 3-foot string.* The object of the game is to use the human crane to transport the tumblers from the start area to the scoring area and create a triangular stack with them. Team members will work in pairs throughout this event.
- *At the whistle, the first pair will use the human crane to hook the first tumbler.* The human crane must be held by one person at each end (not in the middle) and the hook can only be raised or lowered by either bending over and/or rolling the rope around the pipe. The red tape on the rope (about 12 inches above the hook) **MUST** be showing at all times; in other words, there must be at least 12 inches of rope between the body of the crane and its hook.
- Once a tumbler has been hooked, it must be carried to the scoring area, placed down and unhooked. Then the pair returns to the start area, passes the human crane to the next pair and the process repeats.
- *The object is to get as many tumblers to the scoring area as possible in the allotted time, and to stack them to gain more points.* Teams do NOT have to complete a level before attempting to build on top of it, but each level must always have less tumblers than the level immediately below it and the bottom level may have no more than five tumblers.
- *The scoring is outlined below:*
  - Tumblers on bottom level = 1 point each
  - Tumblers on second level = 2 points each
  - Tumblers on third level = 5 points each
  - Tumblers on fourth level = 10 points each
  - Tumblers on fifth (top) level = 25 points

Points are tallied at the end of elapsed time. Cups that fall or tip over earn **NO** points, unless they are re-hooked and re-stacked with the "human crane".



## PENALTIES:

- If the red tape on the rope is rolled onto the crane (leaving less than 12 inches of rope), a team will lose the topmost cup in their scoring stack.
